



# Rescue P.A.W.S. Needs a New Home Fast!

Rescue P.A.W.S. is a well-established non-profit organization committed to rescuing, rehabilitating, and rehoming stray and abandoned animals in Thailand. Our mission is to reduce the stray animal population through sterilization, education, and compassionate care, ensuring every animal receives the second chance they deserve. **Since our inception in 2013, we have sterilized over 12,000 animals in our community, found loving homes for 640 animals and provided over 20,000 life saving vaccinations.**

We are seeking your help to increase our reach and help even more animals in need. **For 10 years, we have operated on the peaceful grounds of the Khao Tao Temple. Sadly, we must find a new home, and time is running out! If we are unsuccessful, we face the heartbreaking possibility of closing our doors, leaving countless animals without the critical care they need.**

**In order to find a new home and expand our operations, We estimate a cost of 10 million baht (USD 275,000).**



## Why We Need Your Help

We are at a critical juncture in our mission. Rescue P.A.W.S. has been given one year to raise the funds necessary to build a state-of-the-art facility in Pranburi. Without this new clinic, we will be forced to close our doors, leaving countless animals without the care they desperately need.

This new facility will enable us to:

- House ill and injured animals
- Provide care for disabled animals
- Offer a safe haven for adoptable animals
- Support cancer patients with specialized care
- Conduct 10,000+ sterilizations annually

This facility, built on 3 rai (1.2 acres) of land donated by local supporters, will provide veterinary care, food, water, and treatment for thousands of stray animals annually.

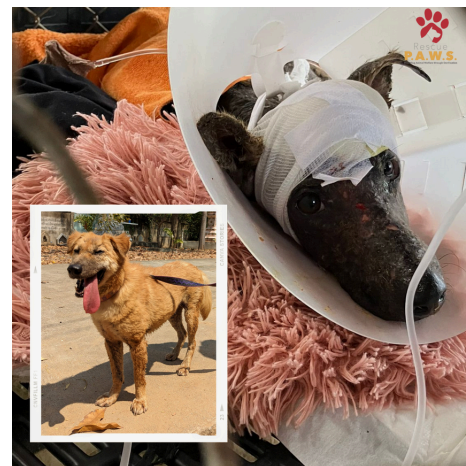
# Saving and Changing Lives Since 2013



Mongkorn was rescued at just 6 months old. Bloodied and scarred, the intense itching caused by mange had led to Mongkorn inflicting terrible wounds all over his body. Today, he has fully recovered and his fur has grown back in. To see him today, you'd hardly recognize that scared puppy, desperately trying to survive on the streets. He's now waiting to travel to his forever home where he will get the second chance he deserves.



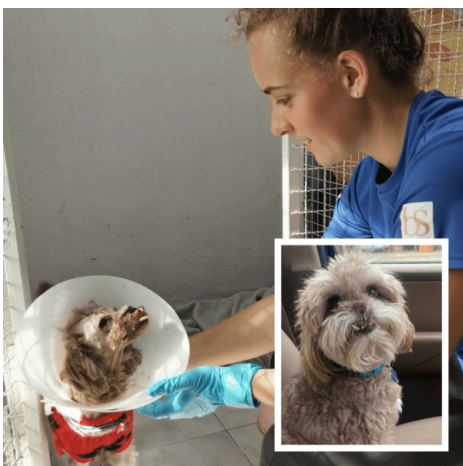
Tam was savagely attacked by a neighboring pack of dogs that were moving into his territory. A fight for resources left Tam with a missing ear and an infection that nearly cost him his life. Thankfully, not only were we able to treat Tam, but we sterilized all of the dogs in his area, added both packs to our feeding run and have eliminated the need for competition and conflict.



Glory arrived at Rescue P.A.W.S. as a shadow of herself—emaciated, malnourished, bald, and suffering from several deep wounds. She was days away from death, with her bones visible and eyes filled with terror. Thanks to our clinic, Glory received the treatment she desperately needed. Today, she is thriving in her foster home, having recently returned to the clinic from Chiang Mai.



Honey Stubbs was found as a puppy. Sadly, she was missing the bottom half of her hind legs. We are unsure on the cause of this injury but it was clear that she could not survive on her own. When she arrived, Honey Stubbs was terrified of people, cowering in a corner. Thankfully, she has begun to trust and is now taking big steps each day to make new friends and enjoy her life. With a pram for easy transport, you can find Stubbsy living her best life on the beach with the other Special Squad Dogs.



Jamook was left at a temple after sustaining life threatening injuries. A witness looked on horrified as she watched a car stop outside the temple,, open the door and drive away leaving behind a small, frail dog that was badly injured. He had lost his nose and the wound was badly infected. Jamook would never have survived at the temple and thankfully he was rescued just moments after being left. After many months of treatment and rehabilitation, Jamook is now a resident of Rescue P.A.W.S. who loves to be involved in all of our events.



Scruffy was a local, known as the golf course that he called home. Sadly, due to his age and malnourishment, Scruffy was attacked by a group of younger dogs and left with a gaping hole in his neck. We were spotted by a golfer in the area who immediately picked up the phone. Scruffy was rushed to our clinic where he received the veterinary care he desperately needed. Scruffy now calls Rescue P.A.W.S. home. He is one of the few dogs that remains with us as a resident as he is unable to be adopted. Scruffy is currently receiving all of the love and care that an old dog needs and no longer worries about where his next meal will come from.
